## Bus lines from Helsinki Railway Square to Dynamicum

55, 55A, 70, 73N, 75, 77,05N. Bus stop is near Kumpula campus, Kustaa Vaasantie. Estimated driving time is 10-12 minutes.

68, 71, 71V, 74N. Bus stop is in front of Arabia shopping centre, Hämeentie 109-111. Estimated driving time is 10-12 minutes.

## Tram

Tramline 6 has its nearest stop in front of Arabia shopping centre, Hämeentie 109-111. Estimated driving time is 16 minutes.



# Helsinki City Transport

## Tourist Ticket

With the Helsinki City Transport's Tourist Ticket you can freely travel in Helsinki on all vehicles - buses, trams, metro, commuter trains and Suomenlinna ferries (note: not on JT-Line water buses). You can choose between a 1-, 3- or 5-day ticket (1-day ticket valid for 24 hours, 3-day for 72 hours and 5-day for 120 hours).

The 1-, 3- and 5-day Tourist Tickets that are bought beforehand are contact cards in which the ticket is ready loaded. The ticket is valid from the moment of the first journey when the ticket is pushed into the slot in the lower part of the card reader.

The Tourist Tickets that are contact cards are sold at the service points of the HKL and the Helsinki Metropolitan Area Council (YTV), R-kiosks located in the city centre and Helsinki City Tourist Information. From the multi-ticket machines you can buy 1-, 3- and 5-day Tourist Tickets of paper. The drivers and the train conductors sell 1-day Tourist Tickets of paper. The tickets that are bought from the ticket machines or a driver are valid from the moment they are bought.

## How to use the contact card

The Tourist Tickets are electronic contact cards. The card has to be activated in the card reader in the beginning of the first journey. The ticket is valid after it has been activated.

How to do it:



- Push the card firmly into the bottom of the slot in the lower part of the ticket machine, the chip side up. The card reader screen will show you the last date and time that the ticket is valid.
- Wait until the card rebounds from the bottom in 4–5 seconds. Then draw the card from the slot.
- Push the card into the card reader every time you enter a bus. On other vehicles you do not need to show the card after the first time of using it, unless asked to do so.
- You can always check the validity of the ticket by pushing it into the card reader.

## **Single ticket**

A single ticket can be bought from the driver or from a ticket machine. It is valid for 60 minutes from the moment of purchase. You can travel with a single ticket freely and change to another tram, metro, bus, commuter train or to the Suomenlinna ferry when the ticket is valid.

With a Helsinki internal single ticket you can travel only within the city of Helsinki. With a regional single ticket you can travel within the whole Helsinki Metropolitan Area (Helsinki, Espoo, Vantaa and Kauniainen).

## **Tram ticket**

With a tram ticket you can travel for an hour on the tram lines. You can transfer to another tram with it. It is not valid on other vehicles. You can buy a tram ticket from the conductor or one of the multi-ticket machines in the city centre.
